

William Martin Appointed Director of Facilities Management at New England Sinai Hospital

STOUGHTON, MA— New England Sinai Hospital President and CEO Lester P. Schindel has announced the appointment and promotion of William Martin as Director of Facilities Management. Martin has been Director of Plant Operations at Sinai since 2005. In his new role, Martin’s management and supervision responsibilities will expand to include environmental services operations, including housekeeping, custodial and linen services for the hospital. “In addition to managing plant operations, general maintenance, HVAC, security, and medical equipment maintenance, Bill will also continue to design and supervise construction of the renovations to our main campus in Stoughton,” said President Schindel.

He also spent nine years working at Raytheon as a Senior Engineer and served as Facilities Manager at Millipore for four years. Martin has a Bachelor of Science degree in Mechanical Engineering from the University of Rhode Island, is a member of the Society for Hospital Engineers and has been a volunteer paramedic for 17 years.
